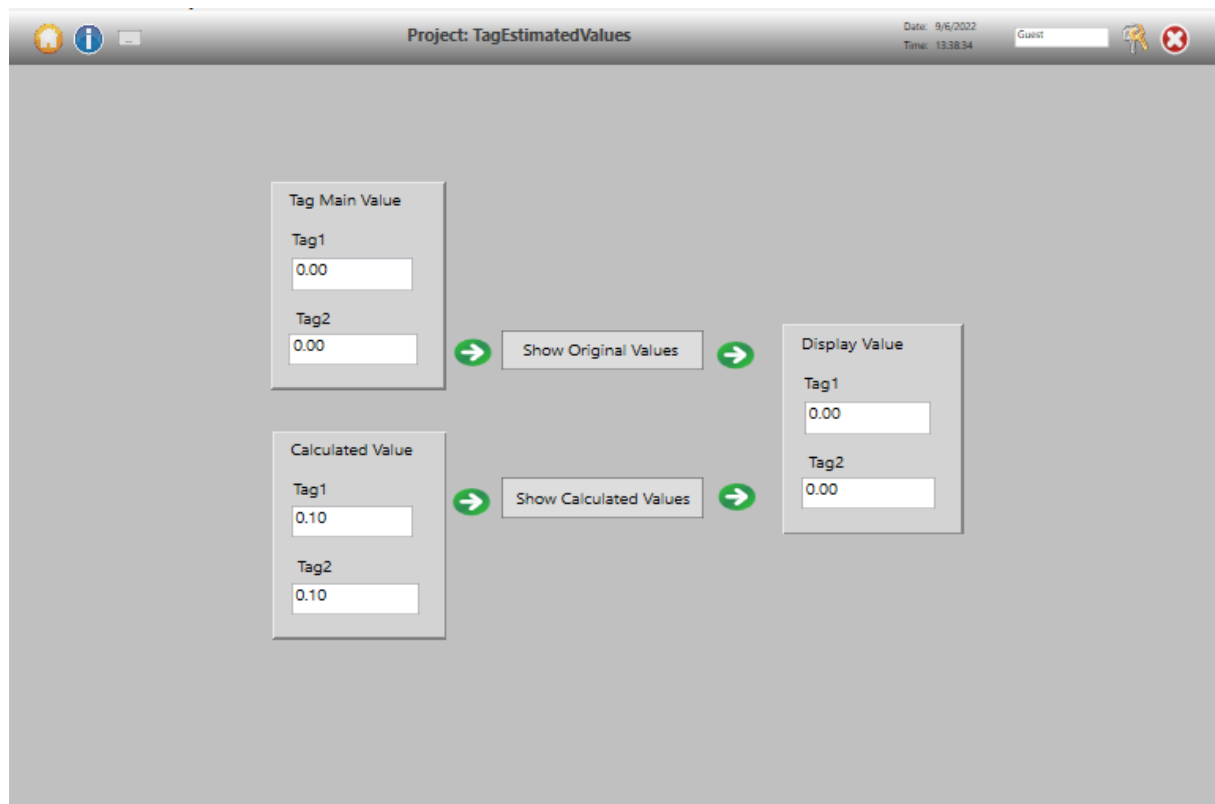

Technical Information

The **DisplayValue** property will show one of the three options: the current value of the tag (Value property).

The **EstimatedValue** tag property (which is a user defined calculation); or a **Historian Value** of the tag.

Using this infrastructure, you can calculate the **EstimatedValue** to be the units conversion for the **Value** property and select if your display or another system will show the units dynamically.
